We have received an application from Fedrigoni Special Papers North America, Inc., a State of Delaware corporation with a mailing address of 465 Saratoga Street, Cohoes, New York. The address of the project is 1 O'Connor Drive, Waterford, New York.

The company has requested that the Agency undertake a project consisting of: A, the acquisition of an interest in an approximately 23.5 acre parcel of land located at 1 O'Connor Drive in the Town of Waterford, New York;

B, the construction on the Land of an approximately 35,000 square foot addition to an existing paper finishing facility to be utilized by the Applicant in connection with its paper

finishing and related operations;

And, C, the acquisition and installation in the Facility of certain furnishings, machinery, and equipment.

The total cost associated with the acquisition, construction, and installation of the Project Facility is presently estimated to equal \$6,750,000.

The Agency is considering whether to undertake the project. If the undertaking of the Project and execution is approved by this Agency, then the Project may be granted such exemptions with respect to a portion of the mortgage recording tax, estimated at \$40,500, to state and local sales tax, estimated at \$227,500, and to real property tax, estimated at \$612,940 as are applicable to manufacturing facilities as described in the Agency's Uniform Tax Exemption Policy adopted on March 11, 1999, and amended last on October 14, 2014, subject to deviation as determined by the Agency.

For the record, my name is Greg Connors.

I'm the president of the Saratoga Economic

Development Corporation, and I speak this morning in support of the application before the Saratoga County IDA and on behalf of Fedrigoni Specialty Papers located at 1 O'Connor Drive, here in the Town of Waterford.

In addition to the Town of Waterford, Fedrigoni operates paper making, finishing, and shipping operations across the globe. Today's scheduled action by the County IDA is a follow-up to an IDA subcommittee presentation on January 14 and a presentation before the full IDA board on March 11th.

The application for final consideration

today proposes a new investment in the Town of Waterford at the existing site of Fedrigoni. The investment is estimated at a total Project cost of approximately \$6.7 million dollars, with the new investment resulting in the construction of an approximate 35,000 square foot addition to the existing facility, the retention of approximately 127 hourly manufacturing full-time jobs, as well as the approximate 227 full-time employees currently working at the Waterford facility.

This Project, if approved, will also create between 25 and 45 construction jobs in Waterford for a period of approximately 12 months.

The application seeks benefits that include sales tax relief, mortgage tax relief totaling approximately \$268,000, and a ten-year manufacturing PILOT with a value of approximately \$613,000, representing a total benefit package of approximately \$881,000 before the applicant's expense.

In my view, the application, as presented, and request for consideration by the County IDA this morning is exactly the reason the
