CHAIRMAN SUTTON: It is 8:35 a.m. on Tuesday, May 19, 2020. I will call to order the public hearing of the Industrial Development Agency of Saratoga County. Please note that the Public Hearing is being held electronically, not in person nor at one specific physical location for the following reasons: because of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Emergency, because of State and Federal bans on large meetings or gatherings, and pursuant to Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 220.1 issued on March 12, 2020 suspending the Open Meetings Law.

As is customary, the Public Hearing scheduled for today May 19, 2020 is being held by the Saratoga County Industrial Development Agency (the Agency) in accordance with the provisions of Article 18-A of the New York General Municipal Law with respect to <u>574</u>

<u>Hudson River Road, LLC (the Applicant)</u> on behalf of <u>Advanced Controls & Automation</u>,

LLC (the Tenant).

The Hearing will be held electronically via a conference call instead of a Public Hearing open for the public to attend. The public has been noticed through advertisement and the Agency's website that members of the public may listen to the Public Hearing and comment during the Hearing on the Project and those benefits which may be granted by the Agency to the Applicant by Dialing: (605)-475-4069 and using Access Code 445131#. Comments may also be submitted to the Agency in writing or electronically via email to mvalentine@saratogacountyny.gov. Minutes of the Public Hearing will be transcribed and posted on the Agency's website.

We have received an application from 574 Hudson River Road, LLC, a limited liability company of New York State now located at 574 Hudson River Road in Halfmoon, New York.

The Company has requested that this Agency undertake a project consisting of (A) the acquisition of an approximately 1.18-acre parcel of land at 574 Hudson River Road (SBL 280.-2-16.2) in the town of Halfmoon, Saratoga County, New York (the Land), (B) the construction of a 7,200-square foot addition (the Addition) to the existing 6,000-square foot facility on that parcel and the Addition is to be leased by the Applicant (574 Hudson River Road, LLC) to be occupied by Advanced Controls & Automation (the Tenant) for use by it in the design and manufacturing of automated control systems and for corporate headquarters, and (C) the acquisition and installation of certain machinery and equipment (the Equipment) in that building, which together with the Land and the Addition being the Project Facility.

The total cost associated with the acquisition, construction and installation of the Project Facility is presently estimated to be \$600,000.

The Agency is considering whether to undertake the Project and finance the Project by executing and delivering a mortgage or mortgages (the Mortgage) to secure a borrowing or borrowings by the Company (the Loan) in an aggregate principal amount sufficient to finance all or a portion of the cost to acquire, construct and install the Project Facility and the cost of the

Loan, with the principal amount currently estimated to be approximately Five Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$525,000).

If the undertaking of the Project and execution and delivery of the Mortgage is approved by this Agency, then (A) the Project may be granted such exemptions with respect to real property taxes, mortgage recording tax, and state and local sales tax as are applicable to manufacturing facilities as described in the Agency's Uniform Tax Exemption Policy adopted on March 11, 1999 and amended last on October 14, 2014, subject to deviation as determined by the Agency, (B) the Project Facility will be acquired, constructed, and installed by the Agency and leased or sold by the Agency to the Applicant pursuant to a project agreement (the Agreement), and (C) the Applicant and the Tenant will be the initial users of the Project Facility, and (D) the the Mortgage will be a special obligation of the Agency payable solely out of certain proceeds of the Agreement and certain other assets of the Agency pledged to the repayment of the Loan.

CHAIRMAN SUTTON: I will now ask our IDA Counsel, James Carminucci if proper legal notice was provided for the Public Hearing in accordance with regulations?

MR. CARMINUCCI: Mr. Chairman, as required by the statute, notice was published in the *Daily Gazette* on May 6th and notice of the hearing was provided to the affected taxing jurisdictions in the Town of Halfmoon, Saratoga County and Waterford/Halfmoon Union Free School District by electronic and postal mail.
